Efudex

- Efudex treats pre-cancerous skin cells by destroying the damaged cells on your skin.
- It not only treats precancerous lesions that are visible but also underlying damaged skin cells that have not yet become visible.
- Stinging, burning, crusting, and peeling are common side effects when applying the cream to the area.
- The more pre-cancerous damage you have the more likely you are to experience these symptoms.
- When you stop treatment, your skin will begin to heal over the next few weeks.
- The new skin may appear redder than normal but will fade over the next few months.

Tips While using Efudex

- Wash your hands immediately after applying Efudex to the area, or apply with gloves on
- DO NOT get Efudex in your eyes or ingest the medication
- Keep away from pets and small children
- Avoid the sun while using Efudex, as the sun can intensify the reaction
- Use a gentle cleanser and moisturizer as directed during treatment
- You may use make-up during treatment
- You may apply Vaseline to the area to aid crusting and prevent infection.
- We recommend applying sunscreen to the area to prevent further sun damage (SPF 30 or higher)
